

Medical Review of SNF PPS Bills by MACS

CMS Revision, 656 Issued 6/15/16

In light of the recent CMS revision issued on 6/15/16, Medicare Contractor Medical Review Guidelines for specific services, we suggest proactive steps to insure beneficiaries continue to meet the level of care requirements as defined in 42CFR409.31.

This revision states: "all Medicare contractors must review some level of SNF PPS Bills based upon data analysis. These reviews are complete reviews and should be reviewed by professionals, i.e., at a minimum, by LPN's."

The Medical Review Analysis will:

- Determine if clinical documentation supports medical necessity and level of care
- Examine if medical diagnosis and rehabilitation diagnosis are supported in the medical record as appropriate
- Determine if MDS assessments are completed and submitted in a timely manner
- · Assess if services are billed in accordance with Medicare Consolidated Billing requirements
- Communicate to management conditions noted in the analysis
- Review the RAI process to help ensure policies, procedures and document formats are designed to direct medically necessary services for regulatory and Medicare Part A compliance
- Determine if accountability and responsibility in facility role designation are part of the RAI process
- Report to management all findings in order for the provider to enhance, grow, and implement a comprehensive RAI process to comply with the Medicare Part A program
